

Justice Reinvestment Training

It is imperative that prosecutors have a clear understanding of the constantly changing legal issues that affect their means to seek justice. This 4-hour course is designed to address the recent passage of The Justice Reinvestment Act.

The curriculum for this course will include an in-depth look at the Justice Reinvestment Act of 2011 and an overview of new sentencing legislation. It will cover changes to the felony sentencing grid, probation and probation revocation hearings, post-release supervision, the habitual felon law, and how to determine a defendant's proper place of confinement. Participants will also complete exercises designed to demonstrate the practical effect of the changes to the law.
