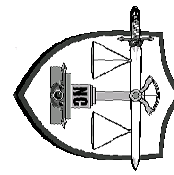

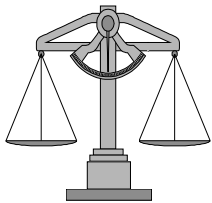

LETHAL WEAPON: DWI Homicide and Assaults



This five-day trial advocacy training course provides the knowledge and skills necessary for prosecutors and law enforcement officers to successfully investigate and prosecute vehicular homicide

and other advanced vehicular cases. This course will take the math and mystery out of the kinematics of crash reconstruction and give you the tools to destroy the defense's crafty calculations of burn-off rate.

This course offers experienced prosecutors activities and presentations that address issues faced both inside and outside of the courtroom. Participants will receive a case file which will be used during the practical exercises. This course was developed in cooperation with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.



It is the prosecutors responsibility to select & recruit a law enforcement officer from their district with prior crash reconstruction training.



Curriculum

Lethal Weapon: DWI Homicide and Assaults

- Role of the prosecutor at the scene of a fatality
- Getting victims to work with you rather than against you
- Common attacks against defense experts' reconstruction and toxicology theories
- Mock trial including a direct examination of an actual crash reconstructionist. In addition, each participant will receive critiques on their performance from their peers and a faculty of experienced prosecutors and law enforcements officers.

All registered students will receive an informational packet and will be reimbursed for mileage and subsistence at the state rate.
