PROSECUTING THE DRUGGED DRIVER

This four and a half-day trial advocacy course will teach both prosecutors and Drug Recognition Experts (DREs) to successfully try impaired driving cases using a DRE as an expert witness. The cross training will require full participation in all phases of a mock trial including the direct examination of an active DRE. In addition, participants will receive critiques on their performance from their peers and a faculty of experienced prosecutors and DREs.

The curriculum for the course contains the following topics:

- LEO training required to become a certified DRE
- DRE evaluation: reading the police report and understanding the evaluation procedure
- Introduction to drugs of impairment along with common signs and symptoms
- The role of the toxicologist in a drug impaired driving case
- How to qualify the DRE as an expert in court
- Responses to common defense challenges
